# HAPPY ANNIVERSARY BLUESTARS!!!!!

48 years and counting for the 48<sup>th</sup>! July 2013 marks the 48<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the 48<sup>th</sup> Assault Helicopter Co, 48<sup>th</sup> Aviation Co, A/3-158<sup>th</sup> or whatever else you might remember us as. The unit designation doesn't matter. What matters is that they're still known as "Blue Star". Now this is something worth noting and celebrating. Not many units from RVN still exist today. July 5<sup>th</sup> marks the actual anniversary of the 48<sup>th</sup>. With that said, our summer mini reunion/anniversary celebration has been scheduled for Friday, July 5<sup>th</sup> from 1300 til the last man standing calls it quits. What???? You need more information? Well, here goes the rest of the story......

The 30<sup>th</sup> Annual VHPA Reunion will be held beginning July 2<sup>nd</sup> through July 7<sup>th</sup>. Our reunion will be held in the great city of San Francisco where everyone will be expected to wear a flower in their hair, or at least those of us who still have hair. This year's reunion hotel is the Hilton San Francisco located at 333 O'Farrell St, SF. The hotel is also known as the Hilton Union Square. There are at least 3 ways to make your hotel reservation while ensuring you receive the VHPA Group Rate of \$119 per night during the period of June 28<sup>th</sup> through July 10<sup>th</sup>.     If you are a Hilton Honors member, provide those details on the second step "Guest Details" screen.
- The hotel's reservation line is 415-771-1400. You should say you want to make a hotel reservation and need to mention any keywords such as "VHPA" or "VHPA National Reunion" so the agent can locate the contract.
- The toll free Hilton central reservations line is 800-445-8667. You should guide the agent to the Hilton San Francisco Union Square property and use the keywords outlined above to find the contract.

Now I don't know about you but getting a room at a Hilton right in the middle of SF for \$119 a night is an incredible deal!

If you're planning to drive, the self-parking fee is \$20 plus tax per day for VHPA attendees. There are large parking structures across the street around the hotel. The Mason O'Farrell Garage's rates are \$32 for 24 hours plus an extra \$1 for in and out privilege.

As usual, I'm a bit tardy in getting this Newsletter out once again. Time just seems to be flying by anymore. The older I get, the older I get faster! I figure that if I ever get the

chance to retire, things might slow down but fat chance of that happening. I'm still chasing around after my 15 year old son so any thought of slowing down is just a pipe dream. #### TOC

Once again, the VHPA will provide us with a TOC free of charge. We'll have a place we can gather throughout the reunion period. The TOC will be in operation from July 3<sup>rd</sup> through July 6<sup>th</sup>. Our "official" mini reunion will be held in our TOC on July 5<sup>th</sup> beginning at 1300. Our TOC room has not yet been designated as of this writing but the location will be posted in the VHPA registration area so look for the signs. I'm not sure what the hotel's policy will be on bringing outside adult beverages into the TOC this year. Every hotel/state is different. Of course we'll make it happen if we can and once again we'll depend on your generosity to "smuggle" in beer, wine, etc and some munchies. It's worked out pretty well in the past so we'll keep our fingers crossed.

#### **Banquet and VHPA Activities**

In addition to our own activities in the TOC, there will be a variety of activities sponsored by the VHPA. As always, you DO NOT have to be a member of the VHPA to attend the reunion. It is open to all. HOWEVER, if you wish to participate in any VHPA activity, you will have to register in order to purchase tickets EXCEPT for the closing banquet. The VHPA has established a non-registered guest cost to purchase Banquet tickets. This year, a non-registered guest can purchase a banquet ticket for \$90. Any event ticket purchases should be done online at the VHPA website. When you purchase a ticket(s) for the banquet, you will be asked your seating preference. Please be sure to indicate that you'd like to sit with the 48<sup>th</sup> or Blue Stars. AND.... Back by popular demand (more like overwhelming demand) will be the NYPD Emerald Society Bagpipers.

#### In Closing.....



Situation: The 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Blue Star Reunion will be conducted from Nov 7 to Nov 10, 2013 in Gettysburg PA.

- **a. General Instructions:** This Order is sent to get everyone notified about how to make reservation and to provide some general planning information. A full agenda with more specific information, cost figures for events and a signup sheet is being generated and will be sent as soon as available.

- c. **Dates of Operation**: Thursday, November 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday, November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2013.
- d. Room Reservations:

Room rates are: \$80 per night plus tax for standard room; \$90 per night plus tax for King Suite.

In order to secure the special room rates, ask for the "Blue Star Reunion;" reservations may be made at any time up to and including the beginning of the reunion; however, reservations made after October 7, 2013 will be on a space available basis.

For those who want to spend extra days prior to the reunion and/or days after the reunion, the special reunion room rate will apply to those reservation dates.

- e. Thumbnail Agenda: This is an overview of the planned events; a detailed agenda will be provided at the TOC along with a detailed listing of "free time" activities which will be available during the reunion.

Banquet is planned for 6:15 with cocktails (cash bar) at 5:30 and memorial at 6:00; a full buffet menu will be provided; cash bar and music will be available throughout with the ability for after dinner dancing.
